BILL DESCRIPTION: Privatization Study

BILL NO: HB 1419

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: North Dakota Workers Compensation, together with its actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, has reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The proposed bill provides for the insurance commissioner to perform a workers' compensation insurance study; and appropriates \$150,000 out of the workers compensation fund for purposes of funding the study.

FISCAL IMPACT: Appropriation of \$150,000 out of the workers compensation fund to fund the cost of the privatization study.
