- 1 A BILL for an Act to repeal section 12 of chapter 594 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended
- 2 by section 1 of chapter 589 of the 1995 Session Laws, relating to the effective date of the
- 3 assumption of the section 404 program of the Clean Water Act by the state; to provide an
- 4 appropriation; to provide an effective date; and to provide an expiration date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. REPEAL. Section 12 of chapter 594 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 589 of the 1995 Session Laws, is repealed.
- 8 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the water
- 9 development trust fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$800,000,
- 10 or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state water commission for the purpose of
- 11 assuming jurisdiction over and administering the section 404 program of the Clean Water Act,
- 12 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003. Upon approval of state
- 13 assumption of the section 404 program by the environmental protection agency, the state water
- 14 commission is authorized five additional full-time equivalent positions to implement this Act.
- 15 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective on the date the state
- 16 engineer certifies to the governor that a program has been designed to effectively assume
- 17 responsibility for the section 404 program of the Clean Water Act and the state water
- 18 commission is ready to assume those responsibilities. The governor shall notify the secretary
- 19 of state and the legislative council of the effective date of this Act.
- 20 **SECTION 4. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through June 30, 2005, and
- 21 after that date is ineffective.
