- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact four new sections to chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code or in the alternative to create and enact four new sections to chapter 15.1-27 of
- 3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the reimbursement of school districts for increases
- 4 in teacher compensation; and to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 2 of
- 5 section 15-40.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code or in the alternative to amend and
- 6 reenact section 15.1-27-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to per student
- 7 payments.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective,
 subdivision a of subsection 2 of section 15-40.1-06 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 2. a. The educational support per student during for the first year of the 1999-2001 2001-03 biennium must be is two thousand one two hundred forty-five forty dollars and. The educational support per student for the second year of the 1999-2001 2001-03 biennium the educational support per student must be is two thousand two hundred thirty fifty dollars and. The educational support per student is the basis for calculating grants-in-aid on a per student basis as provided in sections 15-40.1-07 and 15-40.1-08.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 21 **Definitions.** For purposes of this Act:
 - 1. "Compensation" includes all salaries, benefits, commissions, memberships, the provision of housing, the provision of vehicles, and any other payments, in lieu of

1 payments, or services, reportable as gross income under the Internal Revenue 2 Code. 3 "Teacher" means any individual who is employed by the school district and is <u>2.</u> 4 licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board or approved to 5 teach by the education standards and practices board. The term does not include 6 individuals employed as substitute teachers. 7 **SECTION 3.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to 8 chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 9 Compensation of teachers - Claim for reimbursement. 10 On or before October first of each year or within thirty days after the conclusion of <u>1.</u> 11 the negotiation process provided for in chapter 15-38.1, the board of a school 12 district may file a claim with the superintendent of public instruction for the 13 reimbursement of moneys to be expended by the district during the school year to 14 increase the compensation of teachers employed by the district. 15 2. The claim must include the number of full-time equivalent teachers who received 16 an increase in compensation and the total amount of the increase in compensation 17 to be paid over the amount paid to the teachers for services performed during the 18 previous school year. 19 For purposes of this section, the claim of a district may include proportionate 3. 20 expenditures made by the district to compensate individuals employed as teachers 21 by the special education unit or the area vocational and technology center to which 22 the district belongs. 23 **SECTION 4.** If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to 24 chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: 25 Compensation of teachers - Amount of reimbursement. 26 During the first year of the biennium, each school district is entitled to receive <u>1.</u> 27 reimbursement in an amount equivalent to the lesser of the total increase in 28 compensation to be paid to the teachers for services performed during the current 29 school year over the amount paid to the teachers for services performed during the 30 previous school year or the amount arrived at if the total number of full-time

equivalent teachers employed by the district is multiplied by two thousand dollars.

1	2. During the second year of the biennium, each school district is entitled to receive		
2	reimbursement in an amount equivalent to the lesser of the total increase in		
3	compensation to be paid to the teachers for services performed during the current		
4	school year over the amount paid to the teachers for services performed during the		
5	previous school year or the amount arrived at if the total number of full-time		
6	equivalent teachers employed by the district is multiplied by one thousand five		
7	hundred dollars.		
8	SECTION 5. If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to		
9	chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:		
10	Compensation of teachers - Distribution of reimbursement. The superintendent of		
11	public instruction shall distribute approximately one-sixth of the total amount to which each		
12	school district is entitled under this Act on or before the first day of each November, December,		
13	January, February, March, and June. Prior to distributing the final payment in June, the		
14	superintendent of public instruction shall reconcile the amount actually spent by each school		
15	district for increases in teacher compensation with the amount claimed by the district under		
16	section 3 of this Act and make any necessary adjustments to the June payment.		
17	SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-27-04 of the North Dakota Century Code as		
18	created by House Bill No. 1045, as approved by the fifty-seventh legislative assembly, is		
19	amended and reenacted as follows:		
20	15.1-27-04. Per student payment. The per student payment to which each school		
21	district is entitled for the first year of the biennium is two thousand one two hundred forty-five		
22	forty dollars. The per student payment to which each school district is entitled for the second		
23	year of the biennium is two thousand two hundred thirty fifty dollars. The per student amount is		
24	the basis for calculating state payments to school districts, as provided in sections 15.1-27-06		
25	and 15.1-27-07.		
26	SECTION 7. A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
27	created and enacted as follows:		
28	<u>Definitions.</u> For purposes of this Act:		
29	1. "Compensation" includes all salaries, benefits, commissions, memberships, the

The claim must include the number of full-time equivalent teachers who received 16 an increase in compensation and the total amount of the increase in compensation 17 to be paid over the amount paid to the teachers for services performed during the 18 previous school year. 19 For purposes of this section, the claim of a district may include proportionate 3. 20 expenditures made by the district to compensate individuals employed as teachers 21 by the special education unit or the area vocational and technology center to which 22 the district belongs. 23 **SECTION 9.** A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is 24 created and enacted as follows: 25 Compensation of teachers - Amount of reimbursement. 26 During the first year of the biennium, each school district is entitled to receive <u>1.</u> 27 reimbursement in an amount equivalent to the lesser of the total increase in 28 compensation to be paid to the teachers for services performed during the current
