BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. If House Bill No. 1045 does not become effective, a new section to chapter 15-40.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Contingent funds - Partial tuition reimbursement.

- If funds appropriated by the legislative assembly to the grants foundation aid and transportation line item remain after completion of all statutory obligations, the superintendent of public instruction shall distribute, within the limits of legislative appropriations, partial tuition reimbursements to parents as provided for in this section.
- 2. During the month of March, the parent of any student who attended a nonpublic school since the beginning of the school year may apply to the superintendent of public instruction for a partial reimbursement of the funds expended by the parent on behalf of the student for tuition at a nonpublic elementary or high school in this state. A parent applying for reimbursement under this section shall submit to the superintendent of public instruction a receipt showing payment in full of the tuition owed for the current school year.
- 3. A parent applying for reimbursement under this section is entitled to receive an amount equal to the lesser of:
 - a. Ten percent of the tuition paid to the school by the parent;
