1 A BILL for an Act to provide minimum wage requirements for economic development projects.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Economic development projects - Wage requirements. Any state
entity that provides grants, loans, or any other type of financial assistance for economic
development projects shall require the recipient of the financial assistance to certify that every
full-time employee of the project receiving the financial assistance is paid an income at least
equal to one hundred percent of the federal poverty level for a family of four, as determined
from time to time, for the life of the agreement through which the financial assistance is
provided.
