- WHEREAS, property taxes levied by school districts constitute a majority of all property taxes levied in the state; and
  - **WHEREAS**, property owners have expressed increasing dissatisfaction with the growth of the property tax burden and increasing resistance and rejection of proposed school district bond issues for needed school improvements and building projects; and
  - **WHEREAS**, the Legislative Assembly has on several occasions considered and rejected legislation to allow imposition of income taxes by school districts for support of bond issues and has failed to find a viable alternative to property taxes as a source for school district funding for bond issues and other purposes; and
  - **WHEREAS**, it is apparent that citizens of the state look to the Legislative Assembly to provide alternatives that might be used to relieve some of the burden on property owners for funding school district operations and improvements;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- That the Legislative Council study alternatives, including school district income taxes, for funding sources to reduce school district dependence on property taxes; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
