3	years, and focus specifically on demographic trends as they affect the nature and scope of the
4	services to be delivered, as well as the role of elementary, secondary, and postsecondary
5	education in work force training and economic development initiatives in the state.

12	this state's declining student numbers and sparse population; and
13	WHEREAS, the need exists to evaluate and reevaluate the state and local partnership
14	in education delivery and consequently the training of this state's work force; and
15	WHEREAS, this state's investment in the educational system and consequently work
16	force training has a direct impact on the ability to generate a sound and viable lifestyle for
17	present and future citizens;
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
19	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
20	That the Legislative Council study the delivery of education at the elementary,
21	secondary, and postsecondary levels during the ensuing five, ten, and twenty years, and focus
22	specifically on demographic trends as they affect the nature and scope of the services to be
23	delivered, as well as the role of elementary, secondary, and postsecondary education in work
24	force training and economic development initiatives in the state; and
