

**Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

HOUSE BILL NO. 1095
(Agriculture Committee)
(At the request of the Agricultural Products Utilization Commission)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 4-14.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to compensation of members of the agricultural products utilization commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4-14.1-05 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

4-14.1-05. Agricultural products utilization commission - Reimbursement - Compensation. All members of the agricultural products utilization commission must be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, in the same manner as other state officials are reimbursed, according to sections 44-08-04 and 54-06-09, ~~and if.~~ If not otherwise employed by the state of North Dakota, may receive up to fifty dollars for each regular meeting attended members of the commission are entitled to receive as per diem compensation sixty-two dollars and fifty cents for each day devoted to attending meetings and performing other duties relating to official business of the commission. The commission chairman, if not otherwise employed by the state of North Dakota, may receive an additional one hundred dollars for each day of a regular meeting attended as payment for reviewing and evaluating grant proposals.
