ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1020

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
2 society; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
8 state historical society, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, as
9 follows:

21 **SECTION 2. SPECIAL ROAD FUND.** The amount of \$30,000, or such lesser amount
22 as may be available, included in the Lewis and Clark bicentennial and estimated income line
23 items in section 1 of this Act is from the special road fund and must be used for roadway and
24 parking lot improvements at the Fort Clark state historic site.

- 1 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** The line item entitled capital improvements - Fort Buford
- 2 in section 1 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
