ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2002

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Supreme Court)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;
2 to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
3 relating to salaries of supreme and district court judges; to provide an exemption from the
4 provisions of section 54-44.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code; and to provide for a
5 legislative council study.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
8 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
9 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
10 funds and other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of its
11 various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003, as
12 follows:

24 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There are hereby appropriated any funds received by
25 the supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not
26 otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the
27 purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period
28 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.

29 **SECTION 3. TRANSFERS.** The director of the office of management and budget and
30 the state treasurer shall make such transfers of funds between line items of appropriation for
31 the judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by

1 the court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on
2 properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.

3 **SECTION 4. EXEMPTION.** The district courts' appropriation contained in subdivision 2
4 of section 1 of chapter 2 of the 1999 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of section
5 54-44.1-11 for up to an amount of \$350,000 and any unexpended funds from this appropriation
6 are available to be used to consolidate and integrate the east central judicial district's case
7 management system with the unified court information system used by the other six judicial
8 districts during the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.

9 **SECTION 5. JUDICIAL BRANCH - RECORDS MANAGEMENT.** The judicial branch
10 is encouraged to explore the opportunities of using the electronic document management
11 system services provided by the information technology department for enhanced records
12 management and data storage.

13 **SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - CLERK OF COURT.** The legislative
14 council shall consider studying, during the 2001-02 interim, the implementation of the clerk of
15 court unification including a review of the delivery of services by clerks of court and the
16 responsibility for restitution collection and enforcement activities.

17 **SECTION 7. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-02-02 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
18 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

19 **27-02-02. Salaries of judges of supreme court.** The annual salary of each judge of
20 the supreme court is ~~eighty-three~~ ninety-one thousand ~~eight hundred seven~~ thirty-nine dollars
21 through June 30, ~~2000~~ 2002, and ~~eighty-five~~ ninety-six thousand ~~four~~ six hundred ~~eighty-three~~
22 twenty-two dollars thereafter. The chief justice of the supreme court is entitled to receive an
23 additional two thousand ~~three~~ five hundred ~~sixty-five~~ sixty-nine dollars per annum through
24 June 30, ~~2000~~ 2002, and two thousand ~~four~~ eight hundred ~~twelve~~ ninety-nine dollars per
25 annum thereafter.

26 **SECTION 8. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-05-03 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
27 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

28 **27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges.** The annual salary of each
29 district judge is ~~seventy-seven~~ eighty-four thousand ~~three hundred forty~~ fifteen dollars through
30 June 30, ~~2000~~ 2002, and ~~seventy-eight~~ eighty-nine thousand ~~eight~~ one hundred ~~eighty-seven~~
31 seventy-one dollars thereafter. Each district judge is entitled to travel expenses including

1 mileage and subsistence while engaged in the discharge of official duties outside the city in
2 which the judge's chambers are located. The salary and expenses are payable monthly in the
3 manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a judicial district is entitled to receive an
4 additional one thousand ~~eight~~ nine hundred ~~thirty-one~~ eighty-nine dollars per annum, through
5 June 30, ~~2000~~ 2002, and ~~one~~ two thousand ~~eight~~ six hundred ~~sixty-eight~~ seventy-two dollars
6 thereafter.
