1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the state board of animal health for the purpose
2 of defraying the expenses associated with the control of Johne's disease in North Dakota.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state board of animal health to disburse to
7 livestock producers participating in the North Dakota voluntary Johne's disease herd status
8 program to defray expenses incurred in the testing and control of Johne's disease in livestock
9 and to provide for the education of producers and veterinarians concerning the testing and
10 control of Johne's disease for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003,
11 as follows:

12 Testing assistance	\$105,000
13 Technical assistance	52,500
14 Education	<u>20,000</u>
15 Total general fund appropriation	\$177,500
