1	A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 9-08-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2	relating to contract provisions restraining business.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.	Section 9-08-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5	amended and reenacted as follows:	

- **9-08-06.** In restraint of business void Exceptions. Every contract by which anyone a person is restrained from exercising a lawful profession, trade, or business of any kind is to that extent void, except:
  - One who sells the goodwill of a business may agree with the buyer to refrain from carrying on a similar business within a specified county, city, or a part of either, so long as the buyer or any person deriving title to the goodwill from him the buyer carries on a like business therein.
  - Partners, upon or in anticipation of a dissolution of the partnership, may agree that all or any number of them will not carry on a similar business within the same city where the partnership business has been transacted, or within a specified part thereof.
  - 3. An employee may agree with an employer at the time of employment not to:
    - a. Engage directly or indirectly in the same business or profession as the employer for a period of up to two years from the date of termination of the agreement; or
    - b. Solicit any existing customer of the employer existing at the date of termination within a specified county or counties or such other specified area for a period of up to two years from the date of termination of the agreement if the employer continues to carry on a like business in that area.

- Subsection 3 does not apply to a contract in which a physician or other health care
  provider is a party and in which the physician or other provider agrees to provide
  health care or related services under that contract.
