NORTH DAKOTA UNIVERSITY SYSTEM - DOCTORAL PROGRAMS

The North Dakota University System consists of 11 higher education institutions under the control of the State Board of Higher Education, of which only two--North Dakota State University and the University of North Dakota--have been authorized to offer doctoral programs. The University of North Dakota has 20 doctoral programs and North Dakota State University has 26 doctoral programs. The following is a summary of the doctoral programs offered through the North Dakota University System.
