This bill requires that each live birth that occurs in this State and all fetal deaths be filed directly with the state registrar rather than passing them through the local registrar. This bill will also require that death certificates be filed directly with the state registrar if the state registrar implements an automated system that allows each local registrar to produce certified copies of death certificates within two working days of filing. This will establish a more timely filing of these events as well as provide better service to the public.
