This bill reduces the number of legislative districts by two, from 49 to 47, and the number of legislators by 6, from 147 to 141.

For the remainder of the 2001-03 biennium (December 2002 - June 2003), Legislative Assembly expenditures are anticipated to decrease by \$163,938 (Salaries and wages - \$119,790, mileage and lodging - \$27,348, and other - \$16,800). Legislative Council expenditures are anticipated to decrease by \$5,958 relating to interim meetings.

For the 2003-05 biennium, Legislative Assembly expenditures are anticipated to decrease by \$225,480 (Salaries and wages - \$189,132, mileage and lodging - \$27,348, and other - \$9,000). Legislative Council expenditures are anticipated to decrease by \$48,342 relating to interim meetings.

Although Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council expenditures for the 2001-03 biennium are anticipated to decrease, because the Legislative Assembly has already approved the appropriation for the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council, no appropriation effect is shown for the 2001-03 biennium.

For the 2003-05 biennium, the appropriation for the Legislative Assembly may be reduced by \$225,480 and the Legislative Council by \$48,342.
