Rep. Hawken. Vice - Chairman opened the hearing on HB 1261, a bill for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision h of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 and section 39-12-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the width of forage harvesters and the registration of nonresident harvest vehicles; and to declare an emergency.

Rep. Froelich: He represents District 31. We have many new and different ways of putting up hay and forage — today they chop the hay in the field and bag it much like a silage. The equipment they use it is wide and they are over width. they need to move these for the hay season — the law says July 15th — that is pretty much for harvest equipment moves but haying is earlier; therefore, we propose the June 1st date to cover these forage harvesters. He had received a call who advised that a mover could not get a permit from the DOT because the present law did not provide for it. On page 3 the are other words in there dealing with length and height and those are not my words — the DOT should be able to provide those answers.

Chairman Senator Thomas Trenbeath opened the hearing on HB 1261 relating to the width of storage harvesters and the registration of nonresident harvest vehicles and to declare an emergency.

Representative Rod Froelich (District 31) Introduced HB 1261. He explained the two main changes. First, the state does not have any provisions within the law right now to grant commercial forage harvester permits. Second, the date this can be effective because forage is usually put up in the fall of the year while hay is usually put up earlier. The July 15 date was not a good date and needed to be changed.

The hearing on HB 1261 was closed.

Senator Nething moved a Do Pass. Seconded by Senator Taylor. Roll call vote 5-0-1.

Passed. Floor carrier is Senator Taylor.
