2. Narrative: Identify the aspects of the measure which cause fiscal impact and include any correctants relevant to your analysis.

Section 2, page2, lines 4-6 requires a court to award the prevailing party attorney fees. If this provision is enacted, the Risk Management Fund would incur additional expenses for litigated tort claims and all state agencies would incur additional expenses for litigated contract claims. In addition, the potential for being required to pay the other pany's attorney fees may result in setting claims that otherwise would have been litigated and resolved in favor of the state, or result in the negotiated settlement amount being increased because the plaintiff is aware of the potential of being awarded attorney's fees. As with the federal civil rights act, 42 U.S.C. 1983, it is very possible this bill will increase the number of state law claims against the state because of the possibility of being awarded attorney's fees. The converse is not true in cases where the plaintiff may be judgment proof. Thus, the state bears a greater fiscal burden than the general public for this provision. A prevailing party could always collect from the state. However, if the state prevails, the other party may be judgment proof.

While it is difficult to estimate the number of cases that would be litigated in a biennium, the cost to pay the attorney fees of a prevailing party is set at \$100,000. It is assumed that settling matters of unresolved liability that may possibly be determined in favor of the state would increase the settlement value up to \$50,000.
