House Bill No. 1410 is intended to ease the burden on local political parties and eliminate some of their filing requirements that have little, if any value, and are routinely forgotten by the local political parties.

The bill accomplishes the following:

- Eliminates the requirement that a precinct caucus chairman is required to notify the county auditor of the names of the newly elected precinct committeemen. (Section 1)
- Transfers the burden of reporting to the Secretary of State the names of the party's district chairmen, and any changes in the party's district chairman, from the individual district parties to the state political party. The state parties already notify the Secretary of State of the names of their state officers. (Sections 2 and 3)
- Eliminates the requirement that a district chairman notify the Secretary of State of the names
 of the newly elected district officers and any changes made to the membership of the district
 committee and the Secretary of State would not longer be required to pass that information
 onto the county auditors. (Section 2)
