

Minutes: CHAIRMAN HOLMBERG opened the hearing to HCR 3001. A concurrent resolution relating to authorizing the Budget Section of the Legislative Council to hold required legislative hearings on state plans for the receipt and expenditure of new or revised block grants passed by Congress.

(Meter 2244) STEPHANIE JOHNSON from Legislative Council summarized the resolution about new block grants.

(Meter 2360) SENATOR MATHERN asked why do we need a resolution? Why not just hold the public hearing? (Meter 2400) STEPHANIE JOHNSON stated she did not know why. It is something that is always done. (Meter 2422) SENATOR MATHERN stated he felt that he didn't think it was needed. (Meter 2440) CHAIRMAN HOLMBERG stated he believed the rationale of the resolution was a number of things that happen. The Appropriation committees no longer meet while adjourned and there has to be an mechanism in place if Congress states there is money coming down and you have to have a public hearing.
