Minutes: Chairman Keiser opened the hearing on HCR 3063.

Rep. Scott Kelsh, District 11, Fargo, introduced the resolution that relates to investigating the possibility of potentially implementing an exchange program within North Dakota. Applicants would be nominated, undergo a selection process and be selected to participate in travel to regions and cities around the United States and to foreign countries to meet with community and regional leaders. This could foster an exchange of ideas, build positive relationships and increase awareness of and affinity for the state of North Dakota. This could be implemented in several ways: public/private partnerships, all private or an all public program. A study would determine the best method of implementation. He requested favorable consideration from the IBL Committee.

Rep. Ekstrom: Do you see this as primarily involving travel within the U.S?

Rep. Kelsh: I don't have a breakdown of what percentage would be domestic and what would be international travel.

Rep. Kasper: How many other countries have programs like this? What type of items were you working with and discussing?

Rep. Kelsh: That would be another question that would be determined in the study. The program that I took part in, The American Council of Young Political Leaders, had exchanges with several countries, several of which have troubling political situations and need for liaisons with positive influences. We met with local elected officials, legislative assemblies and parliaments. We toured local points of interest and did cultural tours.

Rep. Nottestad: Do you look at this as a group outside of organizations or how do you see the state fitting in? Have other states set up separate entities for this type of thing?

Rep. Kelsh I'm not sure what the structure of an exchange program like this could do. The idea behind it is that this would also invite other peoples to visit our state, furthering travel opportunities and fostering goodwill.

Chairman Keiser closed the hearing.

Rep. Froseth: This says "directs the Legislative Council". I thought we don't use the language, "shall or direct".

Chairman Keiser: You can use the language "shall consider" which is not directing them.

Rep. Klein: I move to amend that language from direct to shall consider, or whatever language Jennifer approves. Rep. Froseth seconded the motion. A voice vote carried the amendments.

Rep. Ekstrom moved a Do Pass As Amended and to be placed on the consent calendar.

Rep. Kasper seconded the motion. The roll call results were 10-0-3.

Rep. Nottestad will carry this on the floor.
