While it is possible that a large number of nonresident waterfowl hunters could come to North Dakota after the two 10 day periods, early freezes and poor conditions will negatively impact this. It is expected that on an average and based on 2002 conditions, there would be a reduction of 3,000 nonresident hunters per year.
