CHAIRMAN COOK opened the hearing of SB 2181, relating to alcoholic beverage licenses and townships.

SENATOR FREBORG, District 8, introduced SB 2181. In organized townships, the supervisors are responsible for issuing beer and liquor licenses if it is out of any other jurisdiction. If they refuse and SB 2181 were to pass it would allow an appeal to the county commissioners. The commissioners could issue the permit if they could determine the reason was unreasonable.

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Testimony on SB2181 from North Dakota Township Officers

Mr. Chairman, Senator Cook, and Senate Political Subdivisions Committee Members

My Name is Ken Yantes and I represent over 6000 members of the North Dakota Township Officers Association. These grassroots elected officers have developed a policy in opposition to SB2181 which brings me before you here today to ask for your no vote on this bill.

In the past, township government has had the responsibility to refuse issuance of a liquor license within the township and we feel we should continue to do so. We have held the opinion that the affected people of a rural community should have the authority to decide if they want a liquor establishment close to their residences. The concerns voiced at our annual meetings has been increased costs of providing services such as road maintenance and law enforcement needs. Quite often, for those very close by, it tends to disrupt the quality of rural life.

We believe that the county commissioners we have talked to really do not want the responsibility of making this decision and would rather leave it with the townships.

In conclusion, Senate Political Subdivisions Committee, I ask for your vote in opposition to SB2181.
