Minutes:

CHAIRMAN COOK called the committee to order.

CHAIRMAN COOK opened the hearing on SB 2277 relating to the joint exercise of powers by water resource districts.

SENATOR TOM FISCHER, District 46, Fargo ND introduced SB 2277 and ask support for the bill. This bill would recognize a joint water resource district as a political subdivision of the state to conform with the law.

Testimony in opposition of SB 2277

Sandy Clark, ND Farm Bureau, spoke in opposition of SB 2277. They have interpreted the bill differently than Senator Fischer. When the joint water board districts can become political subdivisions, they would not have to have water resource districts, they would have water shed districts or boards. In our policy it is recommended water management boards remain local boards in opposition to water shed boards because those water shed boards do cross county lines.

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They also questioned the taxing authority. If you have an entire water shed district you could be taxing people in that entire district whether they benefit from it or not. We don't want unintended consequences.

SENATOR COOK said that it was his understanding that this bill does not in anyway change how a joint water board will levy special assessments.

Sandy Clark asked if they could have an opportunity to do some further research on SE 2277.

SENATOR COOK replied that there will be an opportunity for the Farm Bureau to do some further research.

No further testimony.

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SENATOR COOK closed the hearing on SB 2277.

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(0.0) CHAIRMAN GLEN FROSETH: I will call the committee to order. The clerk will take the roll: we have a quorum. We will open the hearing on SB 2277.

(3.3) SEN. TOM FISCHER: (Testimony in support) In the last sentence of the Bill it says; A joint board created under this section is a political subdivision of the state. The history of this Bill is when Joint Boards are created, they were not listed as political subdivisions. We've appeared before the Supreme Court last year and they recognized the Cass County Joint Board as a Political Subdivision and that the Century Codes are not included. At the suggestion of our attorney, he felt as though that this amendment should be introduced and clarified. The case law that the Supreme Court had to referred to, it does not give the Joint Water Resource District any more power or taxation of any kind. You've always recognized them as Political Subdivisions.

This just includes Joint Boards in that list.

(4.8) REP. MARY EKSTROM: Is there any consideration of specifically excluding these kinds of Joint Boards from having taxation authority?

(4.9) SEN. TOM FISCHER: These Boards do not have taxation authority per say, they accept their assessment. Except for two counties, each county only has one water board. If they take on a project that's inner district, or inner colony, joint boards are formed to accomplish that. One I could use is the joint board, the farm board in Bismarck which is Burleigh, Oliver, Mercer, McLean, I think that's all. These are joint boards. At Valley City is another one to address, to raise the wall on the dam. They're usually put together for singular projects. They're not ongoing. (6.0) REP. DALE SEVERSON: The compensation of the joint board would be respected to that commission in each county that's paying for that person to come to that joint board, they don't receive funding?

(6.2) SEN. TOM FISCHER: No, when the contributing counties to fund the joint board, either the joint board pays the per diem to those members of the joint board from the funds that are acumitively put together by the Counties or it could be that they are paid by the county that they represent.

(6.7) CHAIRMAN GLEN FROSETH: Support? Opposition? Seeing none, we'll close the hearing on SB 2277. What are the committee's wishes?

(6.9) REP. GIL HERBEL: I MOVE A DO PASS.

(6.9) REP. ALON WIELAND: I SECOND IT.

(7.0) REP. CAROL NIEMIER: To follow up on what Rep. Ekstrom said about give them taxation power if they become a political subdivision?
