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

SB 2340 is the result of the "screw-up" bill, SB 2046, presented to our committee several weeks ago. The intent is to eliminate the need for another 11 page hodge-podge of Century Code corrections. This bill allows the legislative council to change statutory references to numbers and letters to correct references to redesignated or repealed chapters, sections, or portions of sections and to change statutory references to institutions, agencies, offices, and officers to be consistent with other statutory usage. This does not give legislative council the right to alter the sense, meaning, or effect of any law.

I did have one sponsor suggest that we include an amendment that would have the legislative council code reviser report the corrections to the Legislative Council. This could be as simple as a list of sections where the corrections occur. Personally, I don't think that's necessary but if the committee wants to amend the bill to allow for some sort of reporting, that's OK with me.

I would appreciate a chance to vote "yes" on this bill and will even volunteer to carry a "do pass" to the floor. Thanks for your consideration.
