Minutes: Chairman Mutch opened the hearing on SCR 4027. All Senators were present.

SCR 4027 directs the Legislative Council to study whether the use of Bank of North Dakota and State Mill and Elevator profits and the use of moneys in trust funds for general fund purposes is jeopardizing the future economic viability of the Bank of North Dakota and the State Mill and Elevator and reducing the amount of funds available for the dedicated purposes of the trust funds.

Representative Boucher introduced the bill. Legislative Council needs to take a look at what impact State Mill and BND would have on the operations. There are undivided profits of \$140 million. (tape 1, side B, meter no. 950)

Senator Espegard: What will this study show? You are taking profits out and not touching the capitol.

Rep. Boucher: We have moved into the undivided profits. In a study, that would be looked at.

Senator Nething: We should amend this to include that.

Hearing closed. No action taken.

- 11 \$26 million from the student loan trust fund, \$14.3 million from the Permanent Oil Trust
- 12 Fund, and \$38 million from the Health Care Trust Fund; and
- Whereas, the use of Bank of North Dakota and State Mill and Elevator profits and trust
- 14 funds for general funds proposes has made it possible for a balanced budget without the need
- 15 for any general tax increases while continuing to provide for the needs of our most
- 16 vulnerable citizens.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH
- 18 DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
