3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.

- There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to North Dakota state university for the purpose of creating a beef systems center of excellence, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.
- 2. The beef systems center of excellence shall:
 - Create a model for the development of an integrated meat processing industry;
 - b. Enhance North Dakota state university's ability to provide research related to:
 - (1) The effects of genetics, management, and nutrition regimens on carcass yield, quality, and sensory characteristics;
 - (2) Food safety and nutrition of the resulting meat products;
 - (3) New and emerging technologies in slaughter, fabrication, processing and value-added products; and
 - (4) Meat and meat product marketing.
- 3. North Dakota state university may accept gifts, grants, and donations from public and nonpublic sources to support and benefit the creation and efforts of the beef systems center of excellence, and any gifts, grants, and donations so received are appropriated to North Dakota state university for purposes of the beef systems center of excellence.
