

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with House Amendments**

**ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2010**

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the insurance  
2 commissioner.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the insurance regulatory  
6 trust fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other special funds  
7 derived from federal funds and other income, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of  
8 defraying the expenses of the insurance commissioner, for the biennium beginning July 1,  
9 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, as follows:

11 Operating expenses	1,781,501
12 Capital assets	<u>6,900</u>
13 Total special funds appropriation	\$6,486,779

14 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - INSURANCE TAX PAYMENTS TO FIRE**  
15 **DEPARTMENTS AND NORTH DAKOTA FIREFIGHTER'S ASSOCIATION.** There is  
16 appropriated out of any moneys in the insurance tax distribution fund in the state treasury, not  
17 otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,304,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to  
18 the insurance commissioner, of which \$5,200,000 is for the purpose of making payments of  
19 insurance premiums to fire departments and \$104,000 is for the purpose of making two equal  
20 payments to the North Dakota firefighter's association for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003,  
21 and ending June 30, 2005.

22 **SECTION 3. BONDING FUND.** Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$35,000, or  
23 so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state bonding fund to pay bonding fund  
24 administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.

1           **SECTION 4. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND.** Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of  
2 \$813,576, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state fire and tornado fund to  
3 pay fire and tornado fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and  
4 ending June 30, 2005.

5           **SECTION 5. UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT FUND.** Section 1 of this Act includes the  
6 sum of \$35,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state unsatisfied  
7 judgment fund to pay unsatisfied judgment fund administrative expenses for the biennium  
8 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.

9           **SECTION 6. PETROLEUM TANK RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND.** Section 1 of  
10 this Act includes the sum of \$80,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the  
11 petroleum tank release compensation fund to pay petroleum tank release compensation fund  
12 administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.

13           **SECTION 7. ANHYDROUS AMMONIA STORAGE FACILITY INSPECTION FUND.**  
14 Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$175,000, or so much of the sum as may be  
15 necessary, from the anhydrous ammonia storage facility inspection fund to pay for anhydrous  
16 ammonia tank inspection costs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30,  
17 2005.
