Sens. Wardner, Freborg, Grindberg and Reps. Meier, Nelson introduced:

SB 2197: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the payment of retention incentives by school boards; and to declare an emergency.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Education Committee**.

Sens. Erbele, Christmann, Klein and Reps. Drovdal, D. Johnson, Solberg introduced:

SB 2198: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 36-14-04.1, 36-25-01, and 36-25-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to certificates of veterinary inspection and farmed elk; and to provide a penalty.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Erbele, Klein, Nichols and Reps. Belter, Headland, Wald introduced:

SB 2199: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 4-22 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to training for newly elected or appointed soil conservation committee members; and to amend and reenact section 4-22-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the soil conservation committee chairmanship.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Holmberg, G. Lee, Trenbeath and Reps. R. Kelsch, Monson, Mueller introduced:

SB 2200: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-62.2-03.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the student financial assistance and scholars programs.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Education Committee**.

Sens. Klein, Erbele, Nichols and Reps. DeKrey, Froelich introduced:

SB 2201: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 36-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to waivers of requirements for calfhood vaccination against brucellosis; and to amend and reenact section 36-15-21 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to requirements for calfhood vaccination against brucellosis.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Erbele, Espeland, Syverson and Reps. DeKrey, Headland, Pollert introduced:

SB 2202: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-35-17 and 43-35-23 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to continuing education requirements for water well contractors; and to provide an effective date.

Sens. Erbele, Taylor, Trenbeath and Reps. Headland, Schmidt, Weisz introduced:

SB 2203: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-12-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the length of truck-mounted haystack moving equipment.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sens. Wardner, Lyson, Traynor and Reps. Eckre, Kretschmar, Wrangham introduced:

SB 2204: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 28-21-04.1, 32-09.1-07, 32-09.1-20, and 32-09.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the expiration of a garnishment.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Judiciary Committee**.

Sens. Klein, Espeland and Reps. Dosch, Wald introduced:

SB 2205: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 26.1-03-16 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to extension of the time for an insurance company to file a statement with the insurance commissioner.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Industry, Business and Labor Committee**.

Sens. Nichols, Erbele, Urlacher and Reps. Onstad, Pollert, Skarphol introduced:

SB 2206: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 4-09-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to requirements for the sale of seed.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Trenbeath, Fischer and Rep. Nelson introduced:

SB 2207: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06-14 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to license examinations.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sen. Trenbeath and Reps. Grande, Wieland introduced:

SB 2208: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 40-04.1-05, 40-08-10, and 40-09-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the meeting dates of city governing bodies.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Political Subdivisions Committee**.
