If this system had been used in 2002, the number of nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses issued would probably have been about 33,000 instead of the 30,000 that were actually issued. These numbers are used in this estimate.

Note that revenue impacts will vary depending on wetland conditions and resident waterfowl hunter numbers. If 2003 and 2004 are dry years, there could be a significant reduction in license sales.
