The fiscal impact of HB 1385 is difficult to estimate. This bill creates the same regulatory oversight of natural gas purchasers that the Industrial Commission now has over common purchasers of crude oil. To the best of our knowledge the Commission has never been petitioned to hear a case dealing with crude oil purchasers and arguably this legislation would create the same incentive to negotiate fair contracts in the case of gas contracts. However, there are hundreds of gas gathering contracts negotiated each year and if even 10% of them result in Oil and Gas Division hearings, it is estimated that the agency would need an additional 0.75 FTE to perform the required support staff work at \$67,700 salary plus benefits for the 2003-2005 biennium and each following biennium. In 1988 the Commission held 3 hearings dealing with just one gas gathering case.
