This bill establishes a pharmacy loan repayment program. Each year the state health council shall select two pharmacists who are eligible to receive funds over a four-year period, which may not exceed forty thousand dollars. One pharmacist must serve in a community having fewer than two thousand five hundred residents and the other pharmacists must serve in a community having fewer than ten thousand residents. The bill includes an appropriation for \$80,000 for this activity, however year one of the biennium would cost \$20,000 and year two of the biennium would be \$40,000 for a total of \$60,000. Funds for this program will be from the Community Health Trust Fund. The bill also includes a continuing appropriation for the purpose of receiving any conditional or unconditional gift, grant, or donation used toward the repayment of pharmacists' education loans.

Funds for this program will be from the Community Health Trust Fund.

It is estimated that if two pharmacists are selected annually that the cost of the program will be \$60,000 for the 2003-05 biennium and \$140,000 for the 2005-07 biennium.
