If passed, this bill would increase auctioneer and auction clerk license fees from the current level of \$35 per year to \$60 per year. These fees were last increased in 1987. This increase equals approximately 3% per year since the last increase.

The fee increases proposed in this bill would increase general fund revenues by approximately \$29,000 per biennium. Approximately \$18,000 of this amount would come from auctioneer licenses and \$11,000 would come from auction clerk licenses. In 2002, there were 385 licensed auctioneers in North Dakota and 246 licensed auction clerks.
