- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to conduct by school students and staff.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Respect for individuals - Requirements - Complaint process.

- The board of each school district shall require that all staff employed by the district conduct themselves in a manner that promotes respect for each individual, regardless of the individual's age, color, economic status, gender, intellectual ability, physical ability, race, religion, or sexual orientation.
- The board of each school district shall require that all students enrolled in a school
 in the district conduct themselves in a manner that promotes respect for each
 individual, regardless of the individual's age, color, economic status, gender,
 intellectual ability, physical ability, race, religion, or sexual orientation.
- 3. On or before July 1, 2004, the board of each school district shall develop and implement a process within which an individual who has a grievance under this section may file a complaint. The process must include requirements for a full and complete investigation of any complaint filed, written findings to the complainant, disciplinary guidelines, and an appeal to the board of the district.
