1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-03 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to registration of landscape architects by the board of architecture; and

3 to amend and reenact section 43-03-01 and subsection 3 of section 43-03-08 of the North

4 Dakota Century Code, relating to landscape architects.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-03-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 **43-03-01. Definitions.** In this chapter, unless the context or the subject matter

9 otherwise requires:

- 1. <u>"Architect" means an individual who is registered as an architect under this</u>
 chapter.
- 12 <u>2.</u> "Board" means the state board of architecture.
- 13 2. "Architect" means an individual who is registered under the provisions of this
 14 chapter.
- 15 <u>3.</u> "Landscape architect" means an individual who is registered as a landscape
 architect under this chapter.

17 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 43-03-08 of the North Dakota

- 18 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 3. For the regulation of the practice of architecture <u>and landscape architecture</u>.
- 20 SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 43-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is

21 created and enacted as follows:

22 Practice of landscape architecture - Fees - Discipline.

1	<u>1.</u>	An individual may not practice landscape architecture as a profession in this state
2		unless that individual has obtained a certificate of registration from the board and is
3		registered as a landscape architect with the board.
4	<u>2.</u>	An individual may not use the title "registered landscape architect" nor any
5		variation of the same, nor any other words, letters, or device to indicate that
6		individual is a registered landscape architect, without being registered as a
7		landscape architect under this chapter.
8	<u>3.</u>	An applicant for registration as a landscape architect shall pay a registration fee of
9		not to exceed one hundred dollars and must meet qualification requirements the
10		board may adopt by rule.
11	<u>4.</u>	A registered landscape architect shall pay an annual registration renewal fee of not
12		to exceed one hundred dollars. The board may take disciplinary actions against a
13		landscape architect in the same manner as against an architect.
