1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4-35-06.2 and 4-35-06.3 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to the pesticide control board; and to repeal section 4-35-30 of the North
3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the crop protection product harmonization and registration
4 board.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-35-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 **4-35-06.2. ~~Crop protection product harmonization and registration~~ Agriculture**
9 **commissioner - Pesticide control board - Recovery of funds.** The ~~crop protection product~~
10 ~~harmonization and registration board~~ agriculture commissioner may accept, on behalf of the
11 pesticide control board, funds received for expenses paid relating to the registration of
12 pesticides or donations offered to or for the benefit of the pesticide control board. All moneys
13 received under this section must be deposited in the minor use pesticide fund to pay expenses
14 relating to the registration of pesticides or for the specific purpose for which they are given. The
15 pesticide control board shall attempt, whenever possible, to recover funds expended relating to
16 the registration of pesticides and shall adopt rules to administer this section.

17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-35-06.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
18 amended and reenacted as follows:

19 **4-35-06.3. Minor use pesticide fund - Continuing appropriation.** The minor use
20 pesticide fund is created as a special fund in the state treasury. All moneys in the fund are
21 appropriated on a continuing basis to the ~~crop protection product harmonization and registration~~
22 pesticide control board for the purpose of conducting or commissioning studies, investigations,
23 and evaluations regarding the registration and use of pesticides for minor crops, minor uses,
24 and other uses as determined by the board.

1 **SECTION 3. REPEAL.** Section 4-35-30 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
