- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4-35-06.2 and 4-35-06.3 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the pesticide control board; and to repeal section 4-35-30 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the crop protection product harmonization and registration
- 4 board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4-35-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 4-35-06.2. Crop protection product harmonization and registration Agriculture
- 9 <u>commissioner Pesticide control</u> board Recovery of funds. The erop protection product
- 10 harmonization and registration board agriculture commissioner may accept, on behalf of the
- 11 pesticide control board, funds received for expenses paid relating to the registration of
- 12 pesticides or donations offered to or for the benefit of the pesticide control board. All moneys
- 13 received under this section must be deposited in the minor use pesticide fund to pay expenses
- 14 relating to the registration of pesticides or for the specific purpose for which they are given. The
- 15 pesticide control board shall attempt, whenever possible, to recover funds expended relating to
- 16 the registration of pesticides and shall adopt rules to administer this section.
- 17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-35-06.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 18 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 **4-35-06.3. Minor use pesticide fund Continuing appropriation.** The minor use
- 20 pesticide fund is created as a special fund in the state treasury. All moneys in the fund are
- 21 appropriated on a continuing basis to the erop protection product harmonization and registration
- 22 <u>pesticide control</u> board for the purpose of conducting or commissioning studies, investigations,
- and evaluations regarding the registration and use of pesticides for minor crops, minor uses,
- 24 and other uses as determined by the board.

1 **SECTION 3. REPEAL.** Section 4-35-30 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
