**ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1011**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
4 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
5 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
6 other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway  
7 patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, as follows:

14 **SECTION 2. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER.** The less estimated income line item in  
15 section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$7,453,504, or so much of the sum as may be  
16 necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the  
17 direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses  
18 of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.  
19 Of this sum, up to \$847,000 may be transferred only for the purpose of defraying the costs of  
20 operating the Beach, Bowman, and Mooreton weigh stations for the 2003-05 biennium.

21 **SECTION 3. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS.** Each patrol officer of  
22 the state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an  
23 amount not to exceed \$170 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending  
24 June 30, 2005. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses,

- 1 except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at their respective
- 2 home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same manner as salaries are
- 3 paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the presentation of receipts or
- 4 other memorandums.
