# FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments

### ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1179

(At the request of the Insurance Commissioner)

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 26.1-02-27 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to disclosing nonpublic personal information.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-02-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

#### 26.1-02-27. Disclosing nonpublic personal information.

- 1. An insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health maintenance organization that is physically located in the state may not disclose to a nonaffiliated third party a customer's nonpublic personal information contrary to the provisions of title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act [Pub. L. 106-102; 113 Stat. 1436] or contrary to the rules adopted by the commissioner under this section. As used in this section, "customer" means any person that is a resident of or is domiciled in this state and that has or is transacting business with or has used or is using the services of an insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health maintenance organization.
- a. The commissioner may shall adopt rules as may be necessary to carry out this section.
  - <u>b.</u> The rules must be consistent with and not more restrictive than the model regulation adopted by the national association of insurance commissioners entitled "Privacy of Consumer Financial and Health Information Regulation".
  - c. Notwithstanding subdivision b and subject to the exceptions, including the affiliate sharing exception provided for in the national association of insurance commissioner's model regulation, the rules must prohibit the disclosure of nonpublic personal health and financial information concerning an individual

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1		unless an authorization is obtained from the individual whose nonpublic
2		personal health and financial information is sought to be disclosed. As used
3		in this section, "affiliate" includes those companies that are related to one
4		another through a management contract in which one company controls the
5		operations of another.
6	<u>3.</u>	This section does not create a private right of action.
