4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 25-16-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **25-16-07.** Records of treatment or care center confidential.
 - 1. No agent of the department of human services or the superintendent of the developmental center at westwood park, Grafton or the licensee or their agents or employees may disclose the contents of the individual records of a treatment or care center for developmentally disabled persons, nor of the reports received therefrom, except:
- 14 <u>2. b.</u> To officers of the law or any other legally constituted boards or agencies serving the interests of the residents; or
- 16 3. c. To the parents, heirs, or legal guardians of the resident.
- 2. For the purposes of this section, an "heir" must be within four degrees of
 consanguinity. Under this section, an heir is authorized to act as the personal
 representative of a deceased resident regarding the deceased resident's health
 records.
