ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2002

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
2 secretary of state and public printing; to provide an exemption; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
8 secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending
9 June 30, 2005, as follows:

3 **SECTION 2. EXEMPTION.** The appropriation contained in subdivision 1 of section 1 of
4 chapter 2 of the 2001 Session Laws is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11 for an
5 amount of up to \$105,000, and this amount may be used as state matching funds for federal
6 election reform funding available to the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and
7 ending June 30, 2005.

8 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** The election reform line item in subdivision 1 of section 1
9 and section 2 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
