**ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2004**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state auditor.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
4 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
5 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
6 other income, to the state auditor for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state auditor,  
7 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, as follows:

8 Salaries and wages	\$5,981,437
9 Operating expenses	675,204
10 Performance audits	<u>50,000</u>
11 Total all funds	\$6,706,641
12 Less estimated income	<u>2,119,441</u>
13 Total general fund appropriation	\$4,587,200

14 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** Section 1 of this Act includes an appropriation of up  
15 to \$1,264,865 in funds generated by the state auditor from political subdivision audit service  
16 fees for the period beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005. Any amount in excess of  
17 \$1,264,865 must be deposited in the state auditor operating account and made available for  
18 appropriation after June 30, 2005.
