

GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM - TENTATIVE IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE

This memorandum details a potential implementation schedule consistent with the related bill draft. If the committee chooses to recommend a government performance and accountability system, the system could be implemented in three phases as follows:
