

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.**

1 A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article I of the Constitution of North  
2 Dakota, relating to the right of privacy.

3 **STATEMENT OF INTENT**

4 This amendment would provide that the right of individual privacy is essential and may not be  
5 infringed without the showing of a compelling state interest.

6 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**  
7 **SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

8 That the following proposed new section to article I of the Constitution of North Dakota  
9 is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general  
10 election to be held in 2002, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of  
11 North Dakota.

12 **SECTION 1.** A new section to article I of the Constitution of North Dakota is created  
13 and enacted as follows:

14 The right of individual privacy is essential to the well-being of a free society and may not  
15 be infringed without the showing of a compelling state interest.
