- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-52.5 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to employee criminal history record investigation.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-52.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 created and enacted as follows:

6 **Employee criminal history record investigation - Fingerprinting required.** For an
7 individual first employed by the retirement and investment office after July 31, 2005, the
8 executive director of the office shall secure a complete set of fingerprints of that employee if
9 that employee has unescorted physical access to the office or any security-sensitive area of the
10 office as designated by the executive director. The executive director shall ensure that the
11 fingerprints are submitted to the bureau of criminal investigation for verification of the identity of
12 the employee and to obtain criminal history record information and to the federal bureau of
13 investigation for a nationwide background check. The bureau of criminal investigation shall
14 provide any criminal history record information that may lawfully be made available under
15 chapter 12-60 and the response of the federal bureau of investigation to the retirement and
16 investment office.
