1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 7 of section 15.1-27-07 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to payments for kindergarten students.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 7 of section 15.1-27-07 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 7. a. Each school district operating a half-day kindergarten ~~as provided for in~~
7 ~~section 15.1-22-02~~ is entitled to receive the amount of money that results from
8 multiplying the factor ~~.50 adjusted by eighty five percent of the difference~~
9 ~~between .50 and the factor representing~~ that represents the five-year average
10 cost of education per student for ~~this category~~ half-day kindergarten, as
11 determined by the superintendent of public instruction, by the number of
12 half-day kindergarten students in average daily membership in the district,
13 times the per student payment provided for in section 15.1-27-04. ~~Beginning~~
14 ~~July 1, 2004, the factor is that which represents the five-year average cost of~~
15 ~~education per student in this category, as determined by the superintendent of~~
16 ~~public instruction.~~ The payment provided for in this subsection is applicable
17 only to the first twenty-five students in average daily membership per
18 classroom or per teacher.
- 19 b. In order to receive the ~~full~~ per student payment available under ~~this section~~
20 subdivision a, a district must operate a kindergarten program that provides the
21 equivalent of ninety full days of classroom instruction during a twelve-month
22 period. A district is entitled to a prorated payment ~~under this section~~ if it
23 operates a kindergarten program of shorter duration.

- 1 c. Each school district operating a full-day kindergarten is entitled to receive the
2 amount of money that results from multiplying the factor that represents the
3 five-year average cost of education per student for full-day kindergarten, as
4 determined by the superintendent of public instruction, by the number of
5 full-day kindergarten students in average daily membership in the district,
6 times the per student payment provided for in section 15.1-27-04. The
7 payment provided for in this subsection is applicable only to the first
8 twenty-five students in average daily membership per classroom or per
9 teacher.
- 10 d. In order to receive the per student payment available under subdivision c, a
11 district must operate a kindergarten program in accordance with the school
12 calendar requirements set forth in section 15.1-06-04.
