**SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.**

Introduced by

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study methods for the construction  
2 of highways in this state.

3 **WHEREAS**, the highways in this state are necessary for the industries of agriculture  
4 and tourism; and

5 **WHEREAS**, this state spends major sums of money on the construction and repair of  
6 highways; and

7 **WHEREAS**, other states and countries have investigated different methods of highway  
8 construction and the cost effectiveness of certain construction methods over time; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the model used for the interstate system, is considered to be a state of the  
10 art highway;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**  
12 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the legislative council study the methods for the construction of highways in this  
14 state; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the legislative council report its findings and  
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
17 the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly.
