**Poolman:** When we issued our ceased and desist order against professional liability insurance companies, they never responded to it. This gives us more authority to bring those crooks to justice, criminally.

**Poolman:** There is a separate section in code related to that.

#### **TESTIMONY**

Mr. Chairman and members of the committee:

Good morning. My name is Jim Poolman, North Dakota Insurance Commissioner. I stand before you today in support of House Bill No. 1213. Thank you to Representative Dosch for being the prime sponsor on the bill.

This bill amends N.D. Cent. Code § 26.1-02-05 relating to the penalty provided for any unauthorized insurance company or other entity that transacts the unauthorized act of insurance business in the state. Essentially, this section increases the penalty from a Class A misdemeanor to a Class C felony and makes it the same type of penalty as provided in N.D. Cent. Code Chapter 26.1-26 relating to acting as an insurance producer without a license in this state.

As Commissioner, I strongly believe that the increase in the penalty is needed in order to give my office extra enforcement tools to combat the different type of insurance scams and illegal entities that we have seen recently marketing insurance in this state to North Dakota residents without complying with the required insurance laws. Currently, I am able to issue an administrative Cease and Desist Order and impose additional fines if necessary. However, normally these type of unlicensed entities marketing various insurance scams will ignore an administrative penalty and, therefore,

I would like the ability to work with local law enforcement and aggressively pursue criminal penalties in addition to any administrative sanctions taken by my office.

That concludes my testimony on House Bill No. 1213. I encourage a favorable consideration from the committee on this bill. If there are any questions, I would be happy to answer them.
