Chr. Nelson: Is there anyone here to testify in favor of HB 1451? Anybody here to oppose HB 1451? The situation is this: the sponsor would like to withdraw the bill. Given the fact that it was scheduled, we need to open the hearing. If it pleases those who came to testify in opposition, I will open the hearing and close the hearing.

Rep. Drovdal: Mr. Chairman, I believe that once the hearing is scheduled, we have to vote on it. Chr. Nelson: My understanding is that we have to see if there is anybody who wanted to testify on the bill. As long as nobody testified, we haven't officially opened the hearing, and that bill can be withdrawn.

Rep. Hunskor: If I may explain. This bill was put in at the request of a few people in my district. At the time that it was put in, I indicated that the only way I'd do it would be if they'd open their land. They wanted to hunt (gratis) anywhere in the unit, and I said that's not going to fly. They recently called back and said they didn't want that (open own lands), we'd want to be

able to hunt anywhere in the unit and also keep our land closed. I said that wasn't going to work and they pulled it off. They weren't interested in pursuing it further.

Rep. DeKrey: I'm in agreement with the sponsors.

Rep. Drovdal: My comment was more on procedure. It was my understanding that once the bill is set up for hearing, that we have to as a committee send a recommendation.

Rep. DeKrey: I heard you open and close the hearing, I'll move a Do Not Pass.

Chr. Nelson: Rep. DeKrey moves a Do Not Pass on HB 1451, Second by Rep. Porter. Any committee discussion? Call the roll.
