

Minutes:

Chairman Flakoll opened the hearing on HCR 3024, a resolution urging the United States Secretary of Commerce to complete a Taiwan-United States free trade agreement.

Representative Berg introduced the resolution. It is intended to encourage what started last biennium with the trip to Taiwan and some of the opportunities for agricultural products to be sold to Taiwan. Since the resolution has been introduced there has been a report from economy.com where they indicate their optimism on export trade. The dollar has dropped outside of the US, making agricultural products more valuable overseas as well as manufacturing. We are asking to have Taiwan granted observer status at the World Health Assembly. The fundamental problem is this is a long term thorn people's sides, China has blocked Taiwan from being a part of the World Health Organization. There have recently been some severe diseases, such as SARS, that have devastated the Asian community. By having this observer status, it enables WHO to give Taiwan information on how to manage contagious

disease as well as giving them access to scientific and clinical support from around the world.

The US Congress has consistently supported giving Taiwan observer status. The reality is we don't have the votes to be sure it happens. This will strengthen our relationship with Taiwan.

Senator Taylor asked if we are currently paying duty now on all goods from Taiwan. (meter 5297)

Representative Berg said he really doesn't know, his current concern is granting observer status to Taiwan.

Chairman Flakoll closed the hearing on HCR 3024. (meter 5483)

Senator Klein moved a do pass on HCR 3024.

Senator Seymour seconded the motion.

The motion passed on a roll call vote 6-0-0.
