Minutes: Urging the President of the US to protect, defend and support federal antitrust and securities fraud laws.

Senator John (Jack) T. Traynor, Chairman called the Judiciary committee to order. All Senators were present. The hearing opened with the following testimony:

Testimony In Support of the Bill:

Mr. Dana Brandenburg - Past Farmer (meter 5330) Introduced his bill and his experience with Burlington Northern Railroad and Waste management in a yearly contract. Six years ago as a businessman in ND I started picking up rail road ties for the railroad. Sited the newspaper listing Waste Management two and "splitting" a monopoly. Submitted Att. #1, 2, 3, as evidence.

Sen. Robert Erbel - Introduced the bill. (meter 6000) If we can do something then it would be great if not then Mr. Brandenburg could go on with his life.

Sen. Trenbeath asked **Mr. Brandenburg** what he hoped to accomplish with this study? He responded, "exposure for what they did to me". **Sen. Trenbeath** asked if there is any reasonable chance that this study would do this? He stated that "the listings" are his only evidence.

Senator Triplett asked **Mr. Brandenburg** if he has gone to the Attorney Generals Office or the Security and Exchange division? Only ND Attorney generals Office and no one will give it time.

Senator Triplett tried to explain how it is beyond our power to do anything in this matter.

The committee discussed that they needed more evidence or "proof" before they could do any action. It is not our roll to be an investigative body or detective agency, we are here to make laws. Traynor** stated that perhaps he could turn it into a study matter for legislative council?

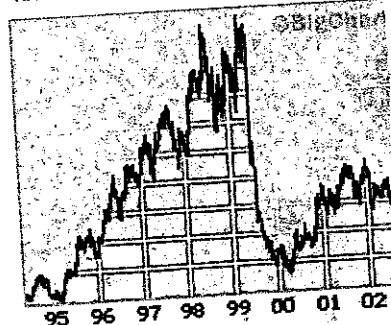

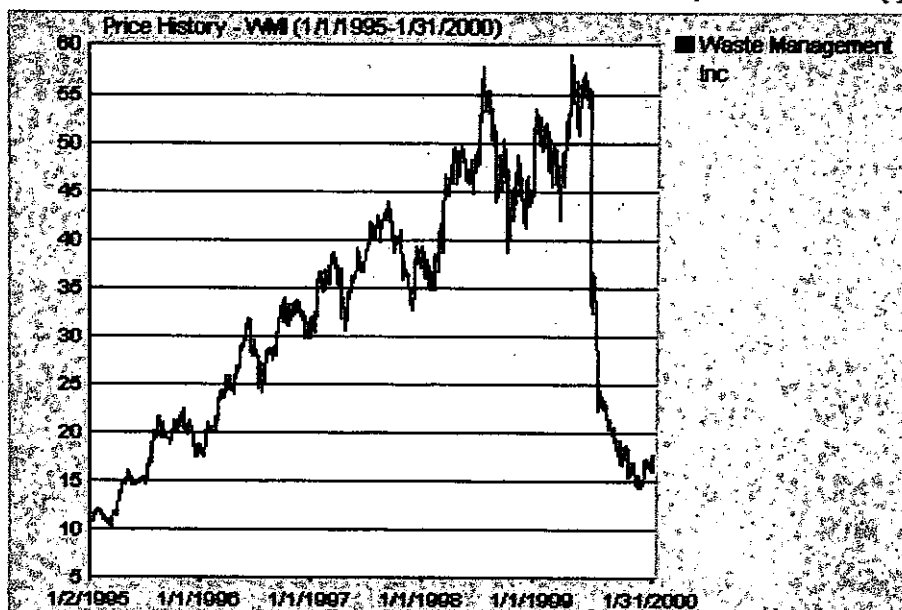
